## THE SEASON OF LENT

The season of great Lent is the season of change. This change is on three dimensions:
Change in our relationship with God. There is no change in this meaning without prayer, deep prayer and repentance in order to regain the splendour of God's image in us.
Change in our relationship with ourselves. There is no change on this level without fasting and mortifying in order to liberate ourselves from every kind of blame and dishonour which can defame the image of God in us. And in order to train our wills to control and hold back the bad habits, intentions and desires and in order to have dominion over myself.
Change in our relationship with our neighbor and every man. Especially with those who are less fortunate, the poor and the needy. By practicing towards them, the works of love, mercy and almsgiving in order to restore the whole or total brotherhood in human race.

There are three ways of change. Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving.
Prayer is a necessity in life and for life- no one can live without God. By prayer every man and woman can have special relation and connection with God. We cannot say Abba O Father without the inspiration of the Holy Spirit who is able to fulfil the entire being of every man and woman who pray and liberate them from immoral, filthy and indecent actions and plant in them the fruits of the Holy Spirit, mentioned by Saint Paul; such as the fruits of love, joy, peace patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, humility, and selfcontrol.
Fasting is a need for every man and woman even it deprives our bodies from the necessity of food and drink, but by fasting we expiate for all our sins and evildoing things and we recompense for them as Saint Paul said; "Christ was without sin, but for our sake God made him share our $\sin$ in order that in union with him we might share the righteousness of God.

In this holy season we are not called to fast only for food and drink, but also for the works of the flesh as mentioned by saint Paul, such as adultery, impurity, immorality, prostitution, worship of idols, witchcraft, enmity, jealousy, anger, envy, separation and so on...
Almsgiving towards those who are less fortunate is an expression of the importance of social justice and of the commandment of loving your neighbor. Jesus told

To this kind of Lent I call my beloved parishioners. And I want you to know from the beginning that this kind of change is the works of God in our lives. So open your hearts and minds, soul and bodies to him and let him dwell in you and remain in you forever. Amen.
