HOLY WEEK DIRECTIVES

Dear brother priests,

upcoming Liturgical For the commemorations for Holy Week, most of our parishes are not doing public liturgies. However, for those who are, and for those offering private liturgy and live streaming, please see the following directives. Palm Sunday: No Processions. Blessed Palms can be distributed in the Church for those who want or in the future for those who are staying home. Palms can be kept as fresh as possible at the parish office for several weeks.

Holy Wednesday: The Rite of the Lamp is always for the sick, and this year the Liturgy takes on a new, more poignant meaning. Holy Oil from the Rite of the Lamp can be placed in individual containers and made available at the parish office for several weeks. <u>Holy Thursday:</u> No Washing of the Feet. No Eucharistic Procession. <u>Good Friday:</u> Signing of the Chalice, No Processions, No kissing of the Cross for Burial of the Lord.

<u>Holy Saturday:</u> Rite of Forgiveness can be celebrated as usual. Easter Sunday: No Processions.



First Reading 2 Corinthians 10:1-7

A reading from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to Corinthians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

I myself, Paul, appeal to you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ I who am humble when face to face with you, but bold towards you when I am away! I ask that when I am present I need not show boldness by daring to oppose those who think we are acting according to human standards. Indeed, we live as human beings, but we do not wage war according to human standards; for the weapons of our warfare are not merely human, but they have divine power to destroy strongholds. We destroy arguments and every proud obstacle raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to obey Christ. We are ready to punish every disobedience when your obedience is complete. Look at what is before your eyes. If you are confident that you belong to Christ, remind yourself of this, that just as you belong to Christ, so also do we.

Gospel Reading Saint Mark 10:46-52

The Apostle Writes:

They came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples and a large crowd were leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar, was sitting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout out and say, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!' Many sternly ordered him to be quiet, but he cried out even more loudly, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!' Jesus stood still and said, 'Call him here.' And they called the blind man, saying to him, 'Take heart; get up, he is calling you.' So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. Then Jesus said to him, 'What do you want me to do for you?' The blind man said to him, 'My teacher, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has made you well.' Immediately he regained his sight and followed him on the way.

This is the truth. Peace be with you.
