HEALING OF THE PARALYTIC



Healing of the Paralytic

"When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, 'Child, your sins are forgiven.' ... He rose, picked up his mat at once, and went away in the sight of everyone. They were all astounded and glorified God, saying, 'We have never seen anything like this.'" - Mark 2:5, 12 The healing of the paralytic reveals the connection between human frailness, suffering, and illness with human sin. We know from the Book of Genesis that God created all things, he created all things as good, and he created man and woman to be stewards of his creation. What entered into God's creation was the mystery of sin, resulting from the failure of human beings to exercise their free will for love of God and neighbor, and to turn inward in an attempt to usurp God's dominion over all. In their attempt to become the masters of life, the mystery of sin reached its ultimate expression in the mystery of death. The images of God who were created for the Kingdom of Heaven, a kingdom of love and peace; took their broken images to the Shoel, the Old Testament term for the shadowy abode of the dead.

In the healing of the paralytic we see that Jesus the Son of God, the Son of Man, is the only one who can re-establish the beauty of creation and the bonds of love between God and human beings, and humans with each other.

The miraculous healings of Christ must always be seen in their connection to his Cross and Resurrection. Jesus is the Divine Physician not merely because he can cure our bodily illnesses, but because he destroys death, the cosmic result of the misuse of our freedom. As Saint Paul said to the Corinthians, "For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Corinthians 5:21)

First Reading 1Timothy 5:24-25, 6:1-5

A reading from the First Letter of Saint Paul to Timothy. Your blessing father... Brothers and Sisters:

The sins of some people are conspicuous and precede them to judgement, while the sins of others follow them there. So also good works are conspicuous; and even when they are not, they cannot remain hidden. Let all who are under the yoke of slavery regard their masters as worthy of all honour, so that the name of God and the teaching may not be blasphemed. Those who have believing masters must not be disrespectful to them on the ground that they are members of the church; rather they must serve them all the more, since those who benefit by their service are believers and beloved. Teach and urge these duties. Whoever teaches otherwise and does not agree with the sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ and the teaching that is in accordance with godliness, is conceited, understanding nothing, and has a morbid craving for controversy and for disputes about words. From these come envy, dissension, slander, base suspicions, and wrangling among those who are depraved in mind and bereft of the truth, imagining that godliness is a means of gain. **Praise be to God always.**

Gospel Reading Saint Mark 2:1-12

The Apostle Writes:

When Jesus returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home. So many gathered around that there was no longer room for them, not even in front of the door; and he was speaking the word to them. Then some people came, bringing to him a paralysed man, carried by four of them. And when they could not bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him; and after having dug through it, they let down the mat on which the paralytic lay. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, 'Son, your sins are forgiven.' Now some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts, 'Why does this fellow speak in this way? It is blasphemy! Who can forgive sins but God alone?' At once Jesus perceived in his spirit that they were discussing these questions among themselves; and he said to them, 'Why do you raise such questions in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, "Your sins are forgiven", or to say, "Stand up and take your mat and walk"? But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins' he said to the paralytic 'I say to you, stand up, take your mat and go to your home.' And he stood up, and immediately took the mat and went out before all of them; so that they were all amazed and glorified God, saying, 'We have never seen anything like this!'

This is the truth. Peace be with you.
