

HEALING OF THE BLIND MAN 6th WEEK OF LENT, HOSANNA WEEK: HEALING OF THE BLIND MAN

Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way. - Mark 10:41-52 The pillars of Great Lent are prayer, repentance, and charity; they are the sack cloth and ashes of our time. Through prayer, repentance, and charity (almsgiving), we approach the Lord Jesus as did the blind man. We have become tired of the darkness of sin, and ask the Master to give us sight.

The sight Jesus gives us is a confirmation of our faith. He tells us that our faith has saved us. What does this mean? Faith is a gift from God, it is the gift of his life within us, through the charismatic power of the Holy Spirit. Faith therefore changes the horizon of our lives, from one created by us which leads to blindness, too the horizon of God which leads to the light of eternal life.

Through prayer we live with God, communicate with God. Through repentance we are made anew, we shed the false self of our own making, and put on Christ. Through charity we extend the love of God to others, we give the gift that was given to us by God to our neighbor.





First Reading 2 Corinthians 10:1-7

A reading from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to Corinthians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

I myself, Paul, appeal to you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ I who am humble when face to face with you, but bold towards you when I am away! I ask that when I am present I need not show boldness by daring to oppose those who think we are acting according to human standards. Indeed, we live as human beings, but we do not wage war according to human standards; for the weapons of our warfare are not merely human, but they have divine power to destroy strongholds. We destroy arguments and every proud obstacle raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to obey Christ. We are ready to punish every disobedience when your obedience is complete. Look at what is before your eyes. If you are confident that you belong to Christ, remind yourself of this, that just as you belong to Christ, so also do we.

Gospel Reading Saint Mark 10:46-52

The Apostle Writes:

They came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples and a large crowd were leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar, was sitting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout out and say, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!' Many sternly ordered him to be quiet, but he cried out even more loudly, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!' Jesus stood still and said, 'Call him here.' And they called the blind man, saying to him, 'Take heart; get up, he is calling you.' So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. Then Jesus said to him, 'What do you want me to do for you?' The blind man said to him, 'My teacher, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has made you well.' Immediately he regained his sight and followed him on the way.
