Lenten Reflection by Our Seminarians

We made it! Well, almost...we are about to enter the second part of Great Lent, and that is Passion Week. We have journeyed with our Lord throughout his ministry, listening to His Word and teachings and witnessing to His miraculous healings. Today, we join Him on His triumphal entry into Jerusalem, where He fulfills the Old Testament prophecy and affirms His role as the long-awaited Messiah. As we begin Passion Week, we continue our journey alongside the Lord, now through His passion up to Calvary, His death upon the Cross, and His foretold resurrection from the tomb.

But before we begin this final stride of our Lenten journey towards the Cross, and ultimately the empty tomb, we pause and rejoice with the children of Jerusalem, exalting "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord," – or do we? In our Divine Liturgy today, we pray to the Lord that we may "go out and meet you." But we pause and reflect on the things in our lives that are keeping us from welcoming the Lord into our circumstances. What keeps us from rejoicing and welcoming our Messiah into our everyday lives, our everyday celebrations, our everyday struggles? Is it pride, that we don't need someone to 'save us' from whatever we may be going through? Is it ignorance, of the love that God has for each one of us? Maybe, we know that love exists, but we struggle to believe we are worthy of it. Is it fear, that if we give up control, things might not go the way we had planned?

Giving up control and surrendering to the will that God has for us is not easy. But we take courage knowing that Jesus had to do the same thing! Zechariah prophesied that a king would come to save, riding on a donkey. (Zech. 9:9) Pope Benedict XVI reflects that Jesus fulfilled this prophecy, not out of his own desires and wishes, but rather based on the obedience to the mission that the Father had given him. His obedience to the will of God allowed the love of God to be poured forth upon humanity and He redeemed her.

Imagine the endless possibilities that we could fulfill through our own lives, if only we welcome Christ into each part of it. As the children spread their cloaks and branches before Him, may we have the courage to spread our entire being, inclusive of all the good and the bad, in front of Him, allowing Him to be glorified in all that we do. Some days might be easier to do this than others, but we are a people of hope and must not succumb. Every day is a new opportunity for us to praise God for whatever He has called us to experience, good or bad, to bring Him into all that is before us, welcoming Him and rejoicing by saying "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Jn. 12:13)

PALM SUNDAY

First Reading Philippians 1:1-13

A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to Philippians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, with the bishops and deacons: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ. It is right for me to think this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart, for all of you share in God's grace with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. For God is my witness, how I long for all of you with the compassion of Christ Jesus. And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight to help you to determine what is best, so that on the day of Christ you may be pure and blameless, having produced the harvest of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ for the glory and praise of God. I want you to know, beloved, that what has happened to me has actually helped to spread the gospel, so that it has become known throughout the whole imperial guard and to everyone else that my imprisonment is for Christ;

Praise be to God always.

Gospel Reading

Saint John 12:12-22

The Apostle Writes:

The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shouting, 'Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord the King of Israel!' Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it; as it is written: 'Do not be afraid, daughter of Zion. Look, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!' His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written of him and had been done to him. So the crowd that had been with him when he called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to testify. It was also because they heard that he had performed this sign that the crowd went to meet him. The Pharisees then said to one another, 'You see, you can do nothing. Look, the world has gone after him!' Now among those who went up to worship at the festival were some Greeks. They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and said to him, 'Sir, we wish to see Jesus.' Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus.

This is the truth. Peace be with you.

لَمَّا سَمِعَ الْجَمْعُ الْكَثِيرَ، الَّذِي أَتَى إِلَى الْعِيدِ، أَنَّ يَسُوعَ آتٍ إِلَى أُورُشَلِيمَ، حَمَلُوا سَعَفَ النَّخْلِ، وَخَرَجُوا إِلَى مُلَاقَاتِهِ وَهُمْ يَصْرُخُونَ: "هُوشَعْنَا! مُبَارَكُ الْآتِي بِاسْمِ الرَّبِّ، مَلِكُ إِسْرَائِيلَ". وَوَجَدَ يَسُوعُ جَحْشًا فَرَكِبَ عَلَيْهِ، كَمَا هُوَ مَكْتُوبٌ: "لَا تَخَافِي، يَا ابْنَةُ صِهْيُونِ، هُوَذَا مَلِكُكَ يَأْتِي رَاكِبًا عَلَى جَحْشِ ابْنِ أَتَانَ". وَمَا فَهَمَ تَلَامِيذُهُ ذَلِكَ، أَوَّلَ الْأَمْرِ، وَلَكِنَّهُمْ تَذَكَّرُوا، حِينَ مُجِدَّ يَسُوعَ، أَنَّ ذَلِكَ كُتِبَ عَنْهُ، وَأَنَّهُمْ صَنَعُوهُ لَهُ. وَالْجَمْعُ الَّذِي كَانَ مَعَ يَسُوعَ، حِينَ دَعَا لِعَازَرَ مِنَ الْقَبْرِ وَأَقَامَهُ مِنْ بَيْنِ الْأَمْوَاتِ، كَانَ يَشْهَدُ لَهُ. مِنْ أَجْلِ هَذَا أَيْضًا لَاقَاهُ الْجَمْعُ، لِأَنَّهُمْ سَمِعُوا أَنَّهُ صَنَعَ تِلْكَ الْآيَةَ. فَقَالَ الْفَرِيسِيُّونَ بَعْضُهُمْ لِبَعْضٍ: "أَنْظُرُوا: إِنَّكُمْ لَا تَنْفَعُونَ شَيْئًا! هَا هُوَ الْعَالَمُ قَدْ ذَهَبَ وَرَاءَهُ!". وَكَانَ بَيْنَ الصَّاعِدِينَ لِيَسْجُدُوا فِي الْعِيدِ، بَعْضُ الْيُونَانِيِّينَ. فَدَنَا هَؤُلَاءِ مِنْ فِيلِبُّسَ الَّذِي مِنْ بَيْتِ صَيْدَا الْجَلِيلِ، وَسَأَلُوهُ قَائِلِينَ: "يَا سَيِّدَ، نُرِيدُ أَنْ نَرَى يَسُوعَ". فَجَاءَ فِيلِبُّسُ وَقَالَ لَأَنْدَرَاوُسَ، وَجَاءَ أَنْدَرَاوُسُ وَفِيلِبُّسُ وَقَالَ لِيَسُوعَ.
