

PALM SUNDAY

"They took branches of palm trees and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna! Elessed is he who comes in the name of the Rord!"

(Sohn 12:13)

Palm Sunday, also called Passion Sunday, in the Christian tradition, the first day of Holy Week and the Sunday before Easter, commemorating Jesus Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

As we welcome Jesus on Palm Sunday, we are invited to embark on a seven-day journey to commemorate our savior's life, death and resurrection. A journey that leads to the empty tomb and allows us to marvel afresh at our freedom as children of God.

The Holy Week reminds us that every step Jesus took toward the cross was taken out of love for the Eternal Father and love for us.

May this week be a time to mediate on God's love for us that freed us from sin and death and a time of thanksgiving for everything God has bestowed upon us.


