Happy Father's Day

Father's Day, in the United States, holiday (third Sunday in June) to honor fathers. Credit for originating the holiday is generally given to Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington, whose father, a Civil War veteran, raised her and her five siblings after their mother died in childbirth. She is said to have had the idea in 1909 while listening to a sermon on Mother's Day, which at the time was becoming established as a holiday. Local religious leaders supported the idea, and the first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910, the month of the birthday of Dodd's father. In 1924 U.S. Pres. Calvin Coolidge gave his support to the observance, and in 1966 Pres. Lyndon B. Johnson issued a proclamation that recognized the day. It became a national holiday in 1972, when Pres. Richard Nixon signed legislation designating the third Sunday of June as Father's Day.

Although it was originally largely a religious holiday, Father's Day has been commercialized with the sending of greeting cards and the giving of gifts. Some observe the custom of wearing a red rose to indicate that one's father is living or a white rose to indicate that he is deceased. Other males—for example, grandfathers or uncles who have assumed parenting roles—are often also honoured on the day. Some Roman Catholics have continued to observe the feast day of St. Joseph, on March 19, as a tribute to fathers.

☐ and 39 beads: 6 of which are large, and 33 small. The small beads represent the 33 years of the mortal life of our Lord.

The first 30 recall to mind the years of His private life, and are divided into 5 groups of 6; the 3 on the pendant recall the public life of the Savior

There are several versions of how to pray the Chaplet.

Introduction Prayer:

The Anima Christi prayer

Soul of Christ, sanctify me.
Body of Christ, save me.
Blood of Christ, inebriate me.
Water from the side of Christ, wash me.
Passion of Christ, strengthen me.
O good Jesus, hear me.
Within your wounds, hide me.
Permit me not be separated from You.
From the malignant enemy, defend me.
At the hour of death, call me And bid me come to You That with Your saints,
I may praise You forever and ever. Amen.

Then Pray:

1 Our Father, 3 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be

On each small bead:

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I implore that I may love You more and more.

OF

Sweet Heart of Jesus, be my love. At the end of each mystery, pray: Sweet Heart of Mary, be my salvation

On each large bead:

(At the end of each set of small beads say)

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You! OR

Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine.

OR

Sacred Heart of Jesus, be my salvation!

At the conclusion of the chaplet:

May the Heart of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament be praised, adored and loved with grateful affection at every moment in all the tabernacles of the world even to the end of time. Amen.

First Reading

1 Corinthians 2:11-16

A reading from the First Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

For what human being knows what is truly human except the human spirit that is within? So also no one comprehends what is truly God's except the Spirit of God. Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit that is from God, so that we may understand the gifts bestowed on us by God. And we speak of these things in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual things to those who are spiritual. Those who are unspiritual do not receive the gifts of God's Spirit, for they are foolishness to them, and they are unable to understand them because they are discerned spiritually. Those who are spiritual discern all things, and they are themselves subject to no one else's scrutiny. 'For who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?' But we have the mind of Christ.

The Apostle Writes:

At that same hour Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, 'I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. All things have been handed over to me by my Father; and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.' Then turning to the disciples, Jesus said to them privately, 'Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! For I tell you that many prophets and kings desired to see what you see, but did not see it, and to hear what you hear, but did not hear it.'
