St. Kyriakos and his Mother Yolitta Martyrs

Feast Day: July 15

<u>Patron</u>: Prayed to for family happiness, and the restoring to health of sick children

St. Yolitta was from a noble family. She married a noble man and had a son. The husband died at an early gee while the son was three years old. He left behind y very large estate. St. Yolitta was a very pious woman and very generous toward the poor. When Diocletian began his persecution of the Christians, St. Yolitta left her native land and her estate and went with her son to Tarsus. When they arrived there, the local governor arrested them. He began interrogating her about her country and her religion. She only answered to all his questions: "I am a Christian." He took her and began torturing her, but she never felt any pain and kept repeating: "I am a Christian." When they took the child, he also began screaming: "I am a Christian." The governor became furious and threw the child from a high building where he landed and died.

His mother watched in sadness but kept praising God. The governor' anger increased and he ordered her beheaded.

St. Yolita and her son Kyriakos earned the crown of martyrdom in the year 305. May their prayers be with us.

First Reading Romans 8:1-11

A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do: by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and to deal with sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, so that the just requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. To set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. For this reason the mind that is set on the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh; you are in the Spirit, since the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit that dwells in you.

The Apostle Writes:
