St Sixtus II - Pope of Rome (257-258) MARTYR



St. Sixtus II, Pope (257-258), was a roman of Greek descent. He was elected to the papacy in the year 257. He, repaired the rift between The Sees of Rome and Carthage that had developed over the issue of baptism and rebaptism.

The Martyrdom of St. Sixtus was dramatic. As he was forbidden to hold service by the emperor Valerian, St. Sixtus and his deacons continued to worship in the chapel at the cemetery.

One Day in the year 258, as the Pope preached, soldiers broke into the chapel and beheaded St. Sixtus with four of his attendants.

First Reading 2 Corinthians 3:7-17

A reading from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

If the ministry of death, chiselled in letters on stone tablets, came in glory so that the people of Israel could not gaze at Moses' face because of the glory of his face, a glory now set aside, how much more will the ministry of the Spirit come in glory? For if there was glory in the ministry of condemnation, much more does the ministry of justification abound in glory! Indeed, what once had glory has lost its glory because of the greater glory; for if what was set aside came through glory, much more has the permanent come in glory! Since, then, we have such a hope, we act with great boldness, not like Moses, who put a veil over his face to keep the people of Israel from gazing at the end of the glory that was being set aside. But their minds were hardened. Indeed, to this very day, when they hear the reading of the old covenant, that same veil is still there, since only in Christ is it set aside. Indeed, to this very day whenever Moses is read, a veil lies over their minds; but when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.
