

The Armor of God

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore, put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people." (Ephesians 6:10-18)

The Armor of God is a powerful metaphor used by the apostle Paul in his letter to the Ephesians (specifically Ephesians 6:10-18). Let's explore this spiritual armor and its significance:

Belt of Truth

Buckle the belt of truth around your waist. It represents honesty, integrity, and the unwavering foundation of God's Word. In a world of deception, this belt keeps us grounded and aligned with God's ultimate reality.

Breastplate of Righteousness

Wear the breastplate of righteousness to guard your heart. It symbolizes moral purity and right living. Satan attacks our identity and worth, but this breastplate protects our spiritual core.

Fitted Feet – Shoes of Peace

Let your feet be fitted with the gospel of peace. This footwear enables you to stand firm and move forward. The gospel brings peace with God and others, even in the midst of spiritual battles.

Shield of Faith

Take up the shield of faith to extinguish the enemy's fiery arrows. Faith is our trust in God's promises. When doubts assail, raise your shield and declare, "I believe!"

Helmet of Salvation

Secure the helmet of salvation on your head. It guards your mind and thoughts. Salvation assures us of eternal life and protects us from despair.

Sword of the Spirit

Grasp the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. It's our offensive weapon. Scripture is powerful—it exposes lies, cuts through darkness, and brings life.

Prayer in the Spirit

Finally, pray in the Spirit at all times. Prayer connects us to God's wisdom, strength, and guidance. Stay alert, intercede for others, and stand strong in the Lord. Remember, the Armor of God equips us for spiritual battles.



Readings

New Sunday

First Reading

2 Corinthians 5:11-21

A reading from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to Corinthians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we try to persuade others; but we ourselves are well known to God, and I hope that we are also well known to your consciences. We are not commending ourselves to you again, but giving you an opportunity to boast about us, so that you may be able to answer those who boast in outward appearance and not in the heart. For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. For the love of Christ urges us on, because we are convinced that one has died for all; therefore, all have died. And he died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for him who died and was raised for them. From now on, therefore, we regard no one from a human point of view; even though we once knew Christ from a human point of view, we know him no longer in that way. So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. So, we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Gospel Reading

Saint John 20:26-31

The Apostle Writes:

A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you.' Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe.' Thomas answered him, 'My Lord and my God!' Jesus said to him, 'Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe.' Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

This is the truth. Peace be with you.
