9th Sunday of Pentecost



Saint Matthew, one of the twelve apostles of Jesus and the author of the Gospel of Matthew, was originally a tax collector named Levi before being called by Jesus to follow Him.

He is often depicted in Christian art with a winged man or angel, symbolizing his role as an evangelist and his emphasis on Jesus' human lineage and fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies.

The Gospel of Matthew is one of the four canonical gospels in the New Testament, presenting the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Key Themes:

- 1. Jesus as the Messiah: Matthew emphasizes Jesus as the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies, establishing Him as the long-awaited Messiah and King of the Jews.
- 2. Kingdom of Heaven: A central theme is the Kingdom of Heaven, with many parables and teachings explaining its nature and how to live as its citizens.
- 3. Jesus' Teachings: The gospel includes the Sermon on the Mount (Chapters 5-7), which outlines key aspects of Christian ethics, the Beatitudes and the Lord's Prayer.
- 4. Authority of Jesus: Matthew highlights Jesus' authority over nature, illness, sin, and even death through various miracles and teachings.

Structure:

- 1. Infancy Narrative (Chapters 1-2)
- 2. Public Ministry (Chapters 3-25)
- 3. Passion and Resurrection (Chapters 26-28

Purpose:

Matthew's gospel aims to confirm to Jewish Christians that Jesus is the promised Messiah and to provide a comprehensive account of His life and teachings, encouraging them to live out their faith in accordance with His teachings.



First Reading

2 Corinthians 5:20-21, 6:1-10

A reading from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians. Your blessing father...

Brothers and Sisters:

We are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake, he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. As we work together with him, we urge you also not to accept the grace of God in vain. For he says, 'At an acceptable time I have listened to you, and on a day of salvation I have helped you.' See, now is the acceptable time; see, now is the day of salvation! We are putting no obstacle in anyone's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry, but as servants of God we have commended ourselves in every way: through great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, beatings, imprisonments, riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger; by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, holiness of spirit, genuine love, truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; in honor and dishonor, in ill repute and good repute. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true; as unknown, and yet are well known; as dying, and see we are alive; as punished, and yet not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing everything.

Gospel Reading

Saint Luke 4:14-21

The Apostle Writes:

Then Jesus, filled with the power of the Spirit, returned to Galilee, and a report about him spread through all the surrounding country. He began to teach in their synagogues and was praised by everyone. When he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, he went to the synagogue on the Sabbath day, as was his custom. He stood up to read, and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written: 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.' And he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. The eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. Then he began to say to them, 'Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.'
