14th Sunday of Pentecost

Feast of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a significant feast in both Catholic and Orthodox traditions, although it is understood and celebrated with some variations.

In Catholicism, the Assumption is defined as the dogma that Mary, the Mother of God, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory at the end of her earthly life. This belief was dogmatically defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950 through the apostolic constitution MUNIFICENTISSIMUS DEUS.

The Church teaches that this event reflects Mary's unique role in salvation history as the Theotokos and her immaculate nature, being free from original sin. The Assumption is celebrated on August 15th and is considered one of the most important Marian feasts, highlighting Mary's exalted place in Heaven as Queen.

In the Orthodox Church, the feast is known as the Dormition of the Theotokos. While the Orthodox tradition also holds that Mary was taken up into Heaven, the emphasis is slightly different. The Dormition, meaning "falling asleep," focuses more on Mary's death and her peaceful passing from this life. According to Orthodox tradition, the apostles were miraculously brought together to witness her death, and three days later, when Thomas arrived late and wished to see her body, her tomb was found empty, confirming her assumption. The Dormition is a major feast, also celebrated on August 15th, and it underscores the Orthodox belief in the holiness and eternal life granted to the Theotokos, as well as the hope of resurrection for all believers.

Both traditions, while differing in theological emphasis, share a deep reverence for Mary and celebrate her entrance into eternal life as a sign of hope and victory over death for all Christians.


