

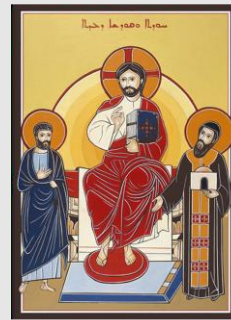

1st Sunday of the Liturgical Year

Blessed New Liturgical Year

The first Sunday in the liturgical year is the Feast of Consecration and Renewal of the church. The feast is either celebrated on one Sunday or two consecutive Sundays.

If November 1st, falls on either a Monday or Tuesday, only one Sunday is observed.

If November 1st, falls on a day other than Monday or Tuesday, two Sundays are observed, as it is the case this year.

But whether we celebrate one Sunday or two Sundays, the core essence of the feast should not change. It is about the renewal and consecration of the Church, not the bricks and walls, but the living stones of the Church; us the Children of God who form the Body of Jesus Christ.

PRAYER

Lord, have mercy on us and save us. Glory to you, Creator of the light that dispels darkness and give joy to your creatures. Create in us, Lord, works of light; disperse the clouds of sin and fill us with the glorious radiance of your grace, for in you we find refuge and call upon you, our Lord and our God, to you be glory for ever. 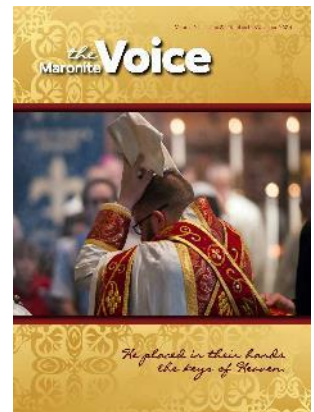

Saint Jude Novena

A heart-warming thank you to the St. Jude Novena Committee and all volunteers for keeping alive the annual St. Jude's Novena which is one of St. Maron's longest standing traditions.

The novena, which originated in the early 1950's, for many years was the region's only devotion dedicated to St. Jude and annually attracted hundreds of devout followers from both the Latin and Maronite traditions from throughout the tri-state area. In fact, at one time there were two novena services every day – 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. – with attendees not only filling the pews, but sitting in folding chairs around the perimeter and, in many instances, standing in the back of the church.

Although our numbers have dwindled in recent years, we remain proud of this tradition which has been passed from generation to generation.

PASTA NIGHT

First Reading Hebrews 9:1-12

**A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews.
Your blessing father...**

Brothers and Sisters,
Even the first covenant had regulations for worship and an earthly sanctuary. For a tent was constructed, the first one, in which were the lampstand, the table, and the bread of the Presence; this is called the Holy Place. Behind the second curtain was a tent called the Holy of Holies. In it stood the golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold, in which there were a golden urn holding the manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant; above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy-seat. Of these things we cannot speak now in detail. Such preparations having been made, the priests go continually into the first tent to carry out their ritual duties; but only the high priest goes into the second, and he but once a year, and not without taking the blood that he offers for himself and for the sins committed unintentionally by the people. By this the Holy Spirit indicates that the way into the sanctuary has not yet been disclosed as long as the first tent is still standing. This is a symbol of the present time, during which gifts and sacrifices are offered that cannot perfect the conscience of the worshipper, but deal only with food and drink and various baptisms, regulations for the body imposed until the time comes to set things right. But when Christ came as a high priest of the good things that have come, then through the greater and perfect tent (not made with hands, that is, not of this creation), he entered once for all into the Holy Place, not with the blood of goats and calves, but with his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption.



Gospel Reading Saint Matthew 16:13-20

The Apostle Writes:

When Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, 'Who do people say that the Son of Man is?' And they said, 'Some say John the Baptist, but others Elijah, and still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.' He said to them, 'But who do you say that I am?' Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.' And Jesus answered him, 'Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father in heaven. And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.' Then he sternly ordered the disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah.

This is the truth. Peace be with you.
